

アメリカ憲法「宗教条項」文献

この文献目録には、アメリカ憲法修正第一条「宗教条項」(Religion Clauses)に関する文献のうち、1999年1月～2005年7月までの代表的な論文・著書を掲載している。ただし、1999年度において、前回(宗教法第19号)で収録された文献は除外している。文献総数は598点である。デュー・プロセス理論(Due Process Theory)などの領域に議論が跨っていても、「宗教の定義」など「宗教条項」にとって不可欠な論点を含む、或いは、巡回裁判所を概観しつつも連邦最高裁の判断と深く関連する論文は取り上げた。論文の表題を概観しても、現代のアメリカ憲法の論点が捉えられる一覧である。
